<b>Description</b>	As part of our risk analysis, all key suppliers directly involved in the value chain of Elmos are to be monitored. These are primarily suppliers and service providers who are involved in the development and creation of our products.	Elmos has set up a whistleblower system with various reporting channels for reporting compliance incidents. Within the digital reporting system, there is a separate module for reporting violations within the supply chain. The aim is not to receive any reports of critical incidents. Should this nevertheless be the case, Elmos has established a dedicated process for dealing with such reports.
